ENTRANCE REQUIREMENTS

General Certificate of Education (GCE) or General Certificate of Secondary Education (GCSE) that is quality assured by Cambridge International Examinations (CIE) provided that the holder of such a Certificate has at one or more examination sitting/s passed a minimum of five approved Ordinary "O" Level subjects, of which:

- At least four must be symbols A, B or C
- No more than one may be a symbol D; and
- At least one must be English Language or English Literature
