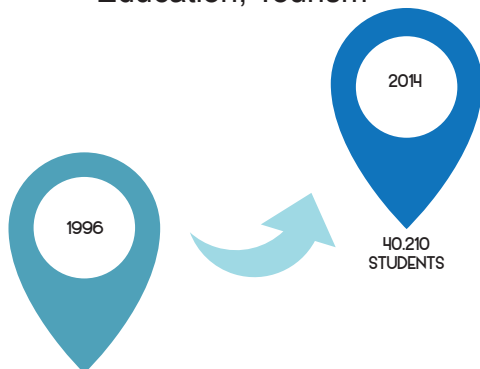
Universidad Rey Juan Carlos founded in 1996 is the youngest public university in **Madrid**.

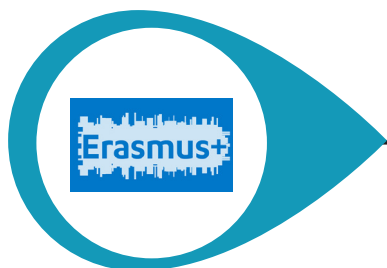
LIVE AN INTERNATIONAL EXPERIENCE

Our own programme with more than 165 agreements outside Europe! More than 15.000 students have enjoyed this programme.

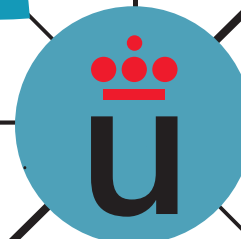
The RCC was created in 1990. Nowadays the agreement is between **Harvard University** and four Spanish Universities in which URJC is part of its council.
